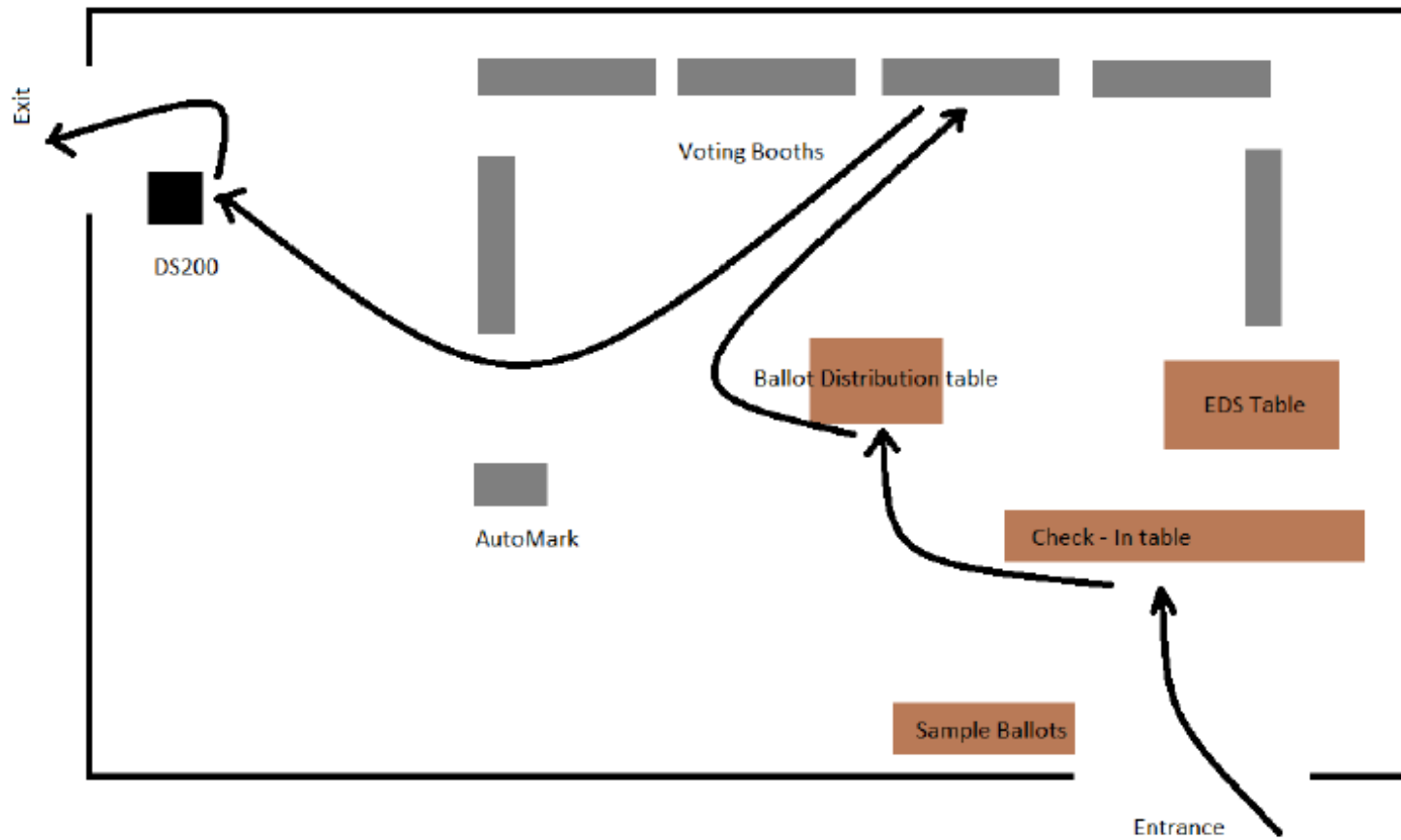

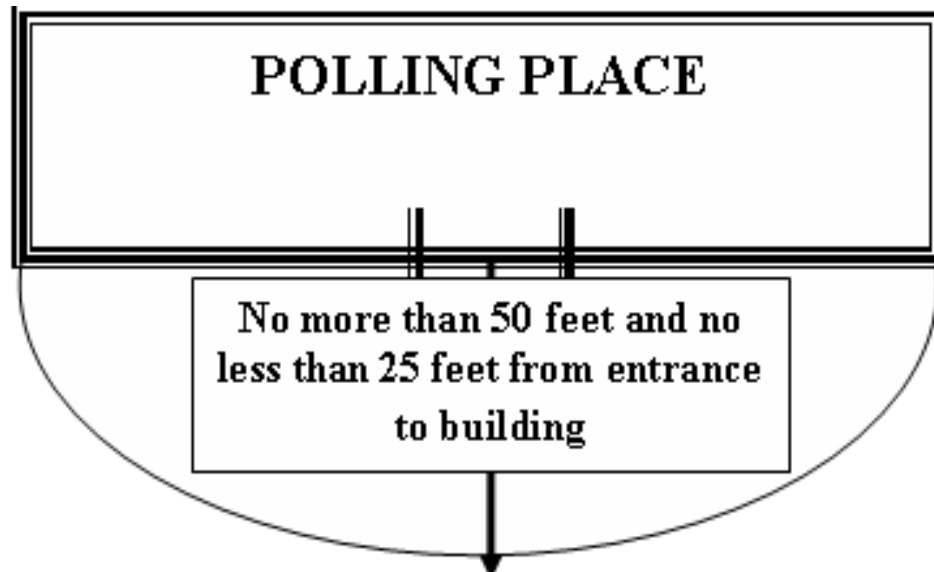
Who is eligible?

- Countywide Primary Election
- Democrats, Republicans, Unaffiliated Voters are eligible.
- Unaffiliated voters must choose one party primary to participate in.
- Libertarians and Green Party Voters are not eligible

Terms and Descriptions



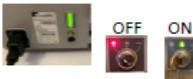
Monday – Setup

1. Confirm correct DS200 for precinct – check label on top lid
2. Check/Verify Seals on Machine Checklist
3. Open rear access panel (silver key) - unwind power plug – plug in DS200
 - o NOTE: access panel will not close with cord out, don't force it closed...leave open
 - o Check power indicator (look through left plexi-glass window): **Amber** = charging / **Green** = Charged
 - o Leave plugged in to charge overnight
4. Take inventory of your ballots; which have been delivered in Main Ballot Bin, inside **Blue Bin**
 - o NOTE: same silver key unlocks both Main Ballot Bin and **Blue Bin**
 - o Verify correct ballot styles **AND** quantities on Ballot Report Form
 - ✓ if correct, lock back inside Main Ballot Bin – apply new seal and record on Machine Checklist
 - ✗ if NOT correct, call BOE immediately.
5. Check/Verify seal on AutoMARK case
6. That's it for Monday night...



Tuesday – Election Morning

1. Remove ballots from Main Ballot Bin and take to Ballot Distribution Area
2. Return **Blue Bin** to ballot bin and make sure top flaps are open and clear
 - o Flaps in open position
3. DS200 open process
 - o Confirm DS200 is still plugged in getting power (check power indicator)
 - o Verify seal numbers on black clamshell lid on Machine Checklist, then remove seals
 - o Unlock black clamshell lid using silver key and raise
 - o Unlock DS200 touchscreen using black barrel key and lift up
 - o Wait 3-5 seconds...screen should power on automatically
 - Enter Election Code (unlock code) when prompted and press **green** Accept button
 - Setup/Configuration tape will print...once complete can be torn off and discarded
 - o Press **green** "Open Poll" button on screen.
 - Zero Tape will print 1 copy automatically.
 - Judges can either remove and sign Zero Tapes now, or leave attached and sign at close of Polls with Results Tapes.
 - o Press **green** "Go to Voting Mode" button.
 - o Screen will display animated ballot graphic and "Welcome. Please insert your ballot."
 - o DS200 is now ready to accept ballots from voters
4. AutoMARK open process
 - o Verify seal and remove; open case...using 2 people (1 on each side), lift and place unit on table
 - o Locate power cord, insert into back and plug in
 - o A **Green** LED indicator will light up in back
 - o The **Red** OFF light at switch will light up in front
 - o Insert gold key and turn switch to ON position
 - o Should see **Green** ON light
 - o Open and lift screen into viewing position
 - o Pull front ballot load tray up.....lay down forward.....push back slightly
 - o Can take 5-7 minutes to power on...ready for ballots



Tuesday – Voting during the day...

Throughout the day voters will insert their MARKED/VOTED ballots into DS200

- o Potential DS200 issues:
 - o **Overvote** – voter marked more choices than allowed – DS200 indicates which office, vote for number and number selected
 - Remedy is voter can press onscreen button to: 1. "Return Ballot", spoil and get new ballot... or 2. "Cast Ballot"
 - o **Unreadable Marks** – DS200 cannot read some marks on ballot
 - Remedy is to spoil that ballot and issue voter a new ballot
 - o **Blank** – voter says they inserted blank ballot in DS200 before marking, and chose to "Cast Ballot" on BLANK BALLOT screen
 - **ONLY** remedy is to issue voter a **Provisional Ballot**
 - o **Ballot Jam** – DS200 experiences a jam, but will clearly indicate if ballot was counted or not.
 - Remedies: 1. check Main Ballot Bin to make sure ballots are not stacked up, not allowing ballots to fall into bin
 - 2. unlock small door in front of DS200, slide DS200 forward slightly, check back of DS200 for ballot(s)
 - o **"Ballot Counted"** – simply place ballot in blue bin with other counted ballots
 - o **"Ballot NOT Counted"** – if jam is cleared, voter puts back in tabulator. If jam not cleared, put in Emergency Bin
- o **Power Outage** – Notify BOE immediately...
 - o **DS200 and AutoMARK have battery backups and will operate uninterrupted for several hours**
 - o Unit will beep at 2 minute intervals, ballot graphic will stop moving, lights in back will go out
 - o If DS200 shuts off completely, remedy is to use Emergency Bin until power restored or unit replaced
 - NOTE: remember to tabulate any ballots in Emergency Bin before end of night

End of Night – Closing Procedures

AutoMARK closing procedure

1. Fold ballot insert slot back up and close.
2. Fold screen down and secure cover using slide clasps on both sides.
3. Insert gold key and turn OFF.
4. Using 2 people, place back inside case...done.

DS200 closing procedure

1. Ensure all voters in line @ 7:30pm have completed voting and inserted ballots into DS200.
2. If Emergency Bin was used, Chief Judge/Judges from both parties should remove ballots from bin and run through DS200.
3. Once all ballots have been tabulated thru DS200:
 - Remove seal from Master USB compartment door...unlock and open using black barrel key
 - Press and HOLD "Close Polls" button for 3 seconds
 - Press **Red** Close Polls button on screen
 - 2 copies of Results Tape and 1 Write-in Report will print out automatically,
 - 1 Results Tape and 1 Write-in Tape go in **red** bag to be returned with supplies by Chief Judge
 - 1 Results Tape goes in envelope to be mailed back to BOE by Judge
4. Once closing/printing is complete screen will indicate polls are closed...press red "**Finished – Turn Off**" button on screen
5. WAIT until screen turns off completely and **red** power button light goes off
 - Remove Master USB stick
 - Place Master USB inside pink zip bag
 - Pink zip bag goes inside **red** bag to return to BOE
 - Close and lock compartment
 - Close and lock DS200 screen
 - Close, lock and reseal black clamshell lid – record new seal number on Machine Checklist
1. Place voted ballots into cardboard box and seal with large **red tape seal**
2. Write Precinct Number on outside of Voted Ballot box(es).
3. Return **VOTED BALLOT** box(es) to Elections Office with other Election Night Supplies
4. Once Ballot Report Form is complete, **place all unvoted ballots back into Blue Bin**
5. Return **Blue Bin** to Main Ballot Bin...lock, reseal and record new seal number on Machine Checklist

Why Am I Casting a Provisional Ballot?

The board of elections needs more information from you to ensure your voter registration complies with the law.

Under federal law (52 U.S.C. 21803) and North Carolina law (G.S. 163-82.4), when a person registers to vote, they must provide their driver's license number or, if they don't have one, the last four digits of their social security number. This information is used to verify your identity. Our records show that you did not provide one of these numbers when you registered.

The North Carolina Court of Appeals recently decided that any voter who lacks one of these numbers in their registration record must vote with a provisional ballot. Poll workers will gather the missing information from you now, and the county board of elections will confirm it with federal and state records. Once this is done, you can continue voting a regular ballot in future elections.

When you complete your provisional ballot form today, please provide your NC driver's license number, or if you don't have one, the last four digits of your social security number. Once this number is confirmed in our system, your provisional ballot will count.

Whether or not you provide your driver's license number or last four digits of your social security number, please also show one of the identification documents listed below. If we are unable to confirm the number you provide with federal and state databases, your vote will still count if you show one of the identification documents below.

If you did not have an identification document below with you today and your identification number does not validate, then you will be contacted by us and you will need to show an identification document no later than noon (12:00 PM) on the Friday after Election Day to have your ballot counted.

Provide Identification Document

The following documents will confirm your identity if you do not have a driver's license or the last four digits of a social security number, or if you provide one of these numbers and it is not confirmed in our system:

- A current and valid photo identification, such as a driver's license
- One of the following documents that is current and shows your name and address: a utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document. *This can be an electronic copy, including on a cell phone.*

The following are examples of acceptable identification documents. Failure to provide this information could result in your provisional ballot not being counted.

ACCEPTABLE IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS

Current and valid photo identification:

- NC driver's license or state ID from the NCDMV
- Driver's license or non-operator card from another state
- U.S. passport book or U.S. passport card
- NC voter photo ID card (issued by county board of elections)
- Student & government-employee photo ID approved by the State Board of Elections
- Military or veteran's ID card
- Tribal enrollment card issued by a tribe recognized by North Carolina or the federal government
- Photo ID card issued by an agency of the U.S. government or North Carolina for public assistance

The following documents that are current and showing name and address:

- Utility bill (including mobile service providers)
- Bank statement
- Paycheck
- Citizenship document issued by the federal government
- Property tax statement issued by a governmental agency
- Vehicle registration issued by a governmental agency
- Government check, including any Social Security, employment, pension, benefit, or reimbursement check from any government entity
- Government invoice, statement, or receipt
- Public housing identification card, lease, or rental statement
- Public educational institution documents, including any student card, transcript, tuition statement, invoice, or receipt issued by any public educational institution
- Government insurance plan card, drug discount card, or drug prescription issued by a government care facility (including military and veterans' facilities)
- Discharge certificates, pardons, or other government documents issued in connection with the resolution of a criminal case, indictment, sentence, or other matter
- Public transportation authority cards, invoices, receipts, or correspondence
- Public assistance or disability agency documents
- Documents issued by any government shelter or temporary/transitional housing facility
- Drug prescription issued by a government doctor or other governmental health care provider

The above list is not exhaustive. Documents that are not listed above are acceptable if they are a utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document.

To be considered "current," the document must be unexpired, if it has an expiration date. **If the document does not have an expiration date, the issuance date must be within six months of the date it is presented to the election official.** An end date for a pay period or billing period is not an expiration date. To determine whether such a document is current, refer to its issuance date. In the absence of an issuance date or expiration date, for a document to be considered current, there must be other time-based indicators on the document showing that it is current.


You can provide either the original document or a copy of that document in paper or electronic format, including by showing the document on a cell phone.

Both sides of Voter Assistance Log

G.S. § 163-166.8. Assistance to voters.

(a) Any registered voter qualified to vote in the election shall be entitled to assistance with entering and exiting the voting booth and in preparing ballots in accordance with the following rules:

- (1) Any voter is entitled to assistance from the voter's spouse, brother, sister, parent, grandparent, child, grandchild, mother-in-law, father-in-law, daughter-in-law, son-in-law, stepparent, or stepchild, as chosen by the voter.
- (2) A voter in any of the following four categories is entitled to assistance from a person of the voter's choice, other than the voter's employer or agent of that employer or an officer or agent of the voter's union:
 - a. A voter who, on account of physical disability, is unable to enter the voting booth without assistance.
 - b. A voter who, on account of physical disability, is unable to mark a ballot without assistance.
 - c. A voter who, on account of illiteracy, is unable to mark a ballot without assistance.
 - d. A voter who, on account of blindness, is unable to enter the voting booth or mark a ballot without assistance.

(b) A qualified voter seeking assistance in an election shall, upon arriving at the voting place, request permission from the chief judge to have assistance, stating the reasons. If the chief judge determines that such assistance is appropriate, the chief judge shall ask the voter to point out and identify the person the voter desires to provide such assistance. If the identified person meets the criteria in subsection (a) of this section, the chief judge shall request the person indicated to render the assistance. The chief judge, one of the judges, or one of the assistants may provide aid to the voter if so requested, if the election official is not prohibited by subdivision (a) (2) of this section. Under no circumstances shall any precinct official be assigned to assist a voter qualified for assistance, who was not specified by the voter.

(c) A person rendering assistance to a voter in an election shall be admitted to the voting booth with the voter being assisted. The State Board of Elections shall promulgate rules governing voter assistance, and those rules shall adhere to the following guidelines:

- (1) The person rendering assistance shall not in any manner seek to persuade or induce any voter to cast any vote in any particular way.
- (2) The person rendering assistance shall not make or keep any memorandum of anything which occurs within the voting booth.
- (3) The person rendering assistance shall not, directly or indirectly, reveal to any person how the assisted voter marked ballots, unless the person rendering assistance is called upon to testify in a judicial proceeding for a violation of the election laws.

(d) Precinct officials shall maintain a log of any individual, other than a minor child under the age of 18 in the care of a voter, who enters the voting place pursuant to this section and is not seeking to vote in that voting place. The log shall include the printed name and address of the individual entering the voting place, the time the individual entered the voting place, and a space for that individual's signature. This subsection shall not apply to observers and runners appointed pursuant to G.S. 163-45.1 and G.S. 163-45.2.

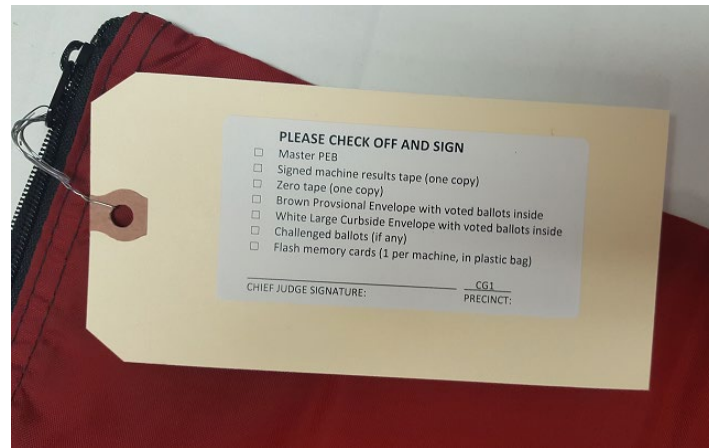

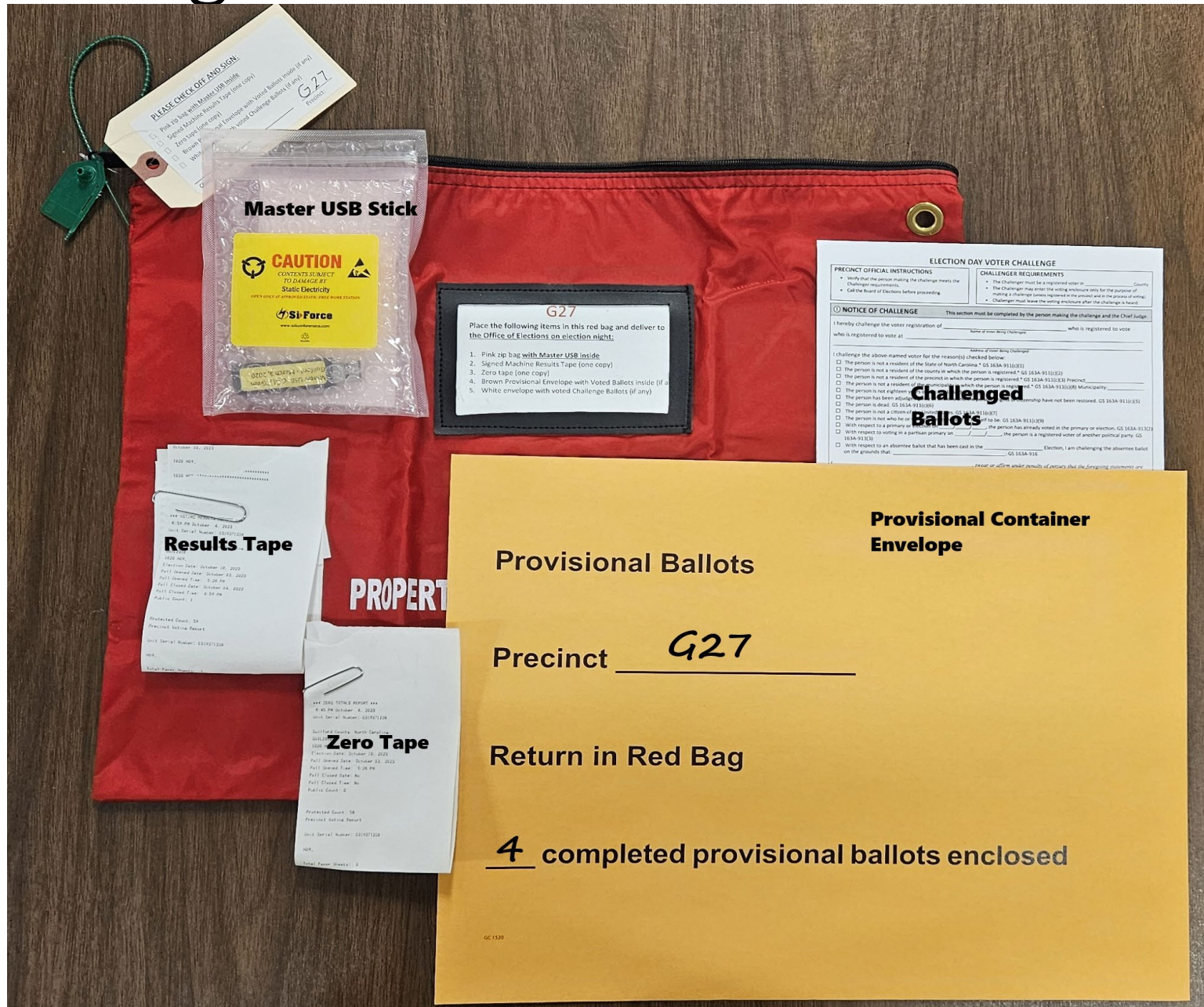

No voter will be denied or turned away from voting because of Photo ID.

Address on the Photo ID does not matter.

Acceptable Forms of Photo ID

Any of the following that is UNEXPIRED or expired for ONE YEAR OR LESS:

- NC Driver License
- U.S. Passport Book/U.S. Passport Card
- State ID from NCDMV (*Non-operator License*)
- NC Voter Photo ID card, issued by a county board of elections
- College/University student ID approved by State Board of Elections
- Charter school employee ID approved by State Board of Elections
- State/local government employee ID approved by State Board of Elections
- Driver's license/non-driver ID from another state, D.C., or U.S. Territory (*only if voter registered in NC within 90 days of election*)

Acceptable Forms of Photo ID (with expiration date - EXCEPTIONS)

- Voters aged 65+ may use an expired ID, if it was unexpired on their 65th birthday.
- If a voter presents an ID that is listed on the State Board of Elections Approved List, that does not have an expiration date on it, it is still ACCEPTABLE.
- Institutions that have been approved by the State Board of Elections have begun making IDs that have expiration dates clearly listed on them. However, anyone who already had an ID before that change was made is allowed to use their ID even though there is not an expiration date printed on it.


65 or older?

A voter 65 or older may use an expired form of any acceptable ID if the ID was unexpired on their 65th birthday.

How to use the Age Guide:

1. Find the voter's year of birth in the left column.
2. Follow the corresponding color line to the right column to find the expiration year.
3. Add the voter's birthdate (month/day) to the expiration year to determine if the voter's ID was valid on their 65th birthday.

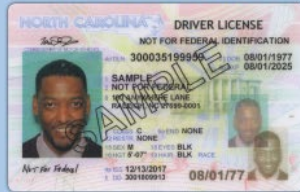
Acceptable Forms of Photo ID (without expiration date)

Any of the following, **regardless of whether the ID contains an expiration or issuance date:**

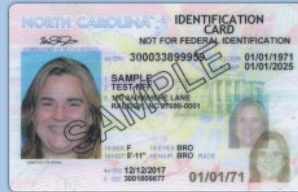
- Military or veteran ID card issued by the U.S. government
- Tribal enrollment card issued by a State or federally recognized tribe
- ID card issued by a U.S. government agency or the State of NC for a public assistance program

These IDs must be valid and unexpired, or been expired for 1 year or less

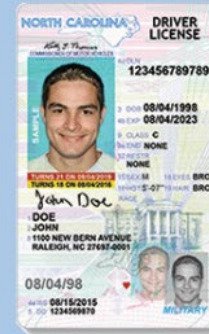
NC Driver License

Other Non-Temporary NC DMV Issued ID Cards



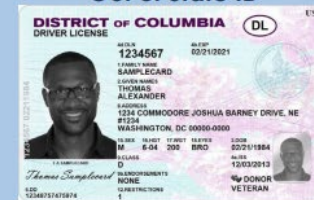
US Passport or US Passport Card

Reviewing a Voter's Photo ID

Inspection of the Photo ID

- Determine if the photo ID is an acceptable type.
- Determine if the photo ID meets expiration requirements.

Evaluation of Reasonable Resemblance (Photo)

- Determine if the photograph on the photo ID looks like the person presenting to vote.

08 NCAC 17 .0101 (a) (2)

“The photograph appearing on the photo identification bears a reasonable resemblance to the person presenting to vote. A reasonable resemblance is a similarity in appearance such that an ordinary person would conclude that the photograph on the identification is more likely than not the person presenting to vote. The election official shall make this determination based on the totality of the circumstances bearing in mind that there are many reasons that a person’s appearance could change (such as, for illustrative purposes only, changes in hair, facial hair, or weight; or the effects of medical conditions, aging, or medical treatment). The election official should also be guided by the purpose of the photo identification requirement, which is to confirm the person presenting to vote is the registered voter on the voter registration records.”

Key Points

- There is no list of the only reasons that are allowed to explain a difference in appearance, because changes in the voter's appearance can occur for any number of reasons. If the election official can confirm the person on the ID matches the person before them, then changes in the voter's appearance cannot prevent them from voting.
- Photographic lighting conditions, ID printing quality, or wear and tear of the photo ID should not be held against the voter if the election official can still use the photo ID to confirm the voter's identity.

Common Examples of Reasons For A Changed Appearance

- A voter's appearance may have changed since their photo ID was issued due to changes in:
 - Weight
 - Hair features and styling, including changes in length, color, hairline, or use of a wig or other hairpiece
 - Facial hair
 - Complexion or skin tone
 - Cosmetics including piercings or tattooing
 - Apparel, including the presence or absence of eyeglasses or contact lenses
- Other factors affecting a voter's appearance in comparison to the photo may include:
 - Effects of aging
 - Effects of medical conditions or medical treatment (e.g., plastic surgery)

Evaluation of Substantial Equivalence (Name)

- Determine if the name on the photo ID is the same or substantially equivalent to the name on the voter's registration.

08 NCAC 17 .0101 (a) (3)

“The name appearing on the photo identification is the same or substantially equivalent to the name contained in the voter’s voter registration record. The election official shall make this determination based on the totality of the circumstances, construing all evidence, along with any explanation or documentation voluntarily offered by the person presenting to vote, in the light most favorable to that person...”

08 NCAC 17 .0101 (a) (3)

“...The election official shall consider the name appearing on the photo identification to be substantially equivalent to the name contained in the registration record if differences are attributable to a reasonable explanation, which shall include but is not limited to one or more of the following reasons:

- A. Omission or inclusion of one or more parts of the name
- B. Use of a variation or nickname rather than a formal name
- C. Use of an initial in place of one or more parts of a given name
- D. Use of a former name, including maiden names, or a variation that includes or omits a hyphenation or hyphen, an accent, or an apostrophe
- E. Ordering of names
- F. Variation in spelling or typographical errors”

Examples of reasonable explanations and finding Substantial Equivalence

- A. Omission or inclusion of one or more parts of the name
 - Mary Beth Smith versus Beth Smith
 - Patrick Todd Jackson, Jr. versus Patrick Todd Jackson
 - Maria Guzman-Santana versus Maria Guzman

- B. Use of a variation or nickname rather than a formal name
 - Bill versus William
 - Sue versus Susanne

- C. Use of an initial in place of one or more parts of a given name
 - A.B. Sanchez versus Aaron B. Sanchez

Examples of reasonable explanations and finding Substantial Equivalence (continued)

- D. Use of a former name, including maiden names, or a variation that includes or omits a hyphenation or hyphen, an accent, or an apostrophe
- Emily Jones versus Emily Gibson
 - Chantell D. Jacobson-Smith versus Chantell D. Jacobson or Chantell D. Jacobson Smith
 - José Muñoz versus Jose Munoz
 - Andrea D'Antonio versus Andrea Dantonio

Examples of reasonable explanations and finding Substantial Equivalence (continued)

E. Ordering of names

- Maria Eva Garcia Lopez versus Maria E. Lopez-Garcia

F. Variation in spelling or typographical errors

- Dennis McCarthy versus Denis McCarthy
- Aarav Robertson versus Aarav Robertsson

08 NCAC 17.0101 (b)

“The election official examining photo identification provided by a person presenting to vote shall not require the voter to provide any additional evidence outside the four corners of the photo identification. The election official shall not require that any person remove apparel for the purposes of determining reasonable resemblance under Subparagraph (a)(2) of this Rule. If the face of the person presenting to vote is covered to such an extent that the election official cannot determine reasonable resemblance, then the election official shall offer the voter the options to vote by provisional ballot...”

08 NCAC 17. 0101 (b) - Breakdown

- You may use other information on the ID to confirm that it is the voter.
 - Hair color; eye color; birthdate
- You cannot ask them for any additional documentation!
 - If they volunteer it, you may consider it, but you CANNOT ask for it.
- You cannot ask them to remove any item on their body!
 - This includes hats, glasses, and face coverings (for BOTH medical and religious reasons)
- If you are unable to determine reasonable resemblance, the voter should be offered a PROVISIONAL.
 - DO NOT TRY TO DETER PEOPLE FROM VOTING PROVISIONALLY!

It does NOT matter if the voter's address is different on their Photo ID from what is listed in the registration book or what the voter says at check-in.

Voter Presents a Photo ID that is NOT ACCEPTABLE

- Inform the person presenting to vote of the reasons for that determination.
 - e.g.: the photo identification is expired when that type of acceptable photo identification requires an expiration date
- Invite the person to provide any other photo identification that is acceptable that the person may have.
- If the person cannot produce an acceptable type of photo ID, inform them of their provisional voting options.
 - Option #1: Vote a provisional ballot, and then bring an acceptable photo ID to the Board of Elections Office before 5:00 pm the day before Canvass.
 - Option #2: Vote a provisional ballot with an affidavit claiming an exception to the identification requirement.

Option #1: Provisional Ballot – No Exception Form

- Vote a provisional ballot, and then bring an acceptable photo ID to the Board of Elections Office before 5:00 pm the day before Canvass.

Option #2: Provisional - Exception -

- Vote a provisional ballot with an affidavit claiming an exception to the identification requirement.
- The voter must fill out and indicate an exception

Photo on ID Does Not Reasonably Resemble the Voter/ Name is Not Substantially Equivalent

- The check-in official shall initiate a challenge and immediately notify the Chief Judge.
- *Fill out a Help Referral Form*
- Check the “No Resemblance” or “Name not substantially equivalent” box, then sign your name in the evaluation section
- Chief Judge and Judges will each make a determination and vote on the issue
 - If all three UNANIMOUSLY agree there is no reasonable resemblance or the name is not substantially equivalent, write an explanation on the lines provided and check the “Provisional Ballot” box. Complete the Provisional Process for this voter.
 - If even ONE of the three thinks there is reasonable resemblance, check the box that says “Regular Ballot” and allow the voter to check in and vote as normal.

Final Reminders:

- Reasonable Resemblance, bearing in mind that appearances change
- Name must be substantially equivalent, looked at in the light most favorable to the voter
- Address on ID does not matter
- To deny an ID, it takes a unanimous vote by the CJ and Judges – otherwise voter votes a regular ballot
- Whether voter does not have ID or it was denied, voter may vote a provisional ballot – and either bring it to the BOE office later or use the ID Exception Form
