There are approximately 33,329 veterans

living in Guilford County, including many who are returning home from active duty. The Guilford County Veterans Service Office can assist veterans, military personnel, and their dependents with applying for benefits. Our Veterans Service Officers (VSO's) assists them through the process to qualify for disability compensation, non-service connected pension, health care, burial and other benefits from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs (VA).

While the Veterans Services Office is not part of the federal VA, we have trained professionals to explain VA procedures, prepare and file claims, review VA decisions and advise applicants about various federal, state and local benefits that they may be entitled to. As part of our commitment to outreach, we are available to speak at community meetings, veteran's service organizations, and other local agencies.

Guilford County Veterans Services was established shortly after World War II to assist veterans, widowers of veterans, spouses of veterans and children of deceased or disabled veterans. We provide veterans and their families with valuable guidance as they navigate the federal veterans' benefits system.

Guilford County Veterans Services recognizes the sacrifices made by veterans and their families, and are proud to assist veterans of the U.S. Army, U.S. Marine Corps, U.S. Navy, U.S.

Air Force, U.S. Coast Guard, North Carolina National Guard and Reserve Forces.



FILING CLAIMS

Veterans or claimants filing a claim for benefits will need medical records, military discharge documents (DD214) and appropriate federal VA forms, which will be supplied by this office or can be obtained online. We will assist you with obtaining these documents if they are not available. Guilford County Veteran Service Officers are accredited by the North Carolina Division of Veterans Affairs and American Legion. The service organization will serve as their power of attorney to assist in the filing process. VA forms are available online at www.va.gov/vaforms/ or at the County office.
