The Juvenile Crime Prevention Council (JCPC) has studied the risk factors and needs of Juvenile Court involved youth in this county and hereby publishes this Request for Proposals (RFP). The JCPC anticipates funds from the NC Dept. of Public Safety Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention in the amount stated above to fund the program types specified below. Such programs will serve delinquent and at-risk youth for the state fiscal year 2026-2027 beginning on, or after, July 1, 2026. The use of these funds in this county require a local match in the amount specified above. The county can approve programs for 1-year funding awards, dependent on county approval and programs meeting all requirements.

Based on identified needed programs and possible gaps in the service continuum, the following program types will be considered for funding:

Proposed program services should target the following risk factors for delinquency or repeat delinquency: School Behavior Problems, Alternatives to Short Term School Suspensions/Truancies, Pro-Social Peer Rejection and Association with Other(s) Involved in Delinquent Activity, Weapon Violence, Substance Abuse/Use, Youth Association with Gang Members, Vocational Development and Skills, and Family Criminality.

Proposed services should address the following concerns as reported in the Youth Assessment Screening Instrument (YASI) for adjudicated youth:

Peer Domain: Associate with peers/associates with negative/delinquent influence, and gang members

Individual Domain: Guilford County youth have previous weapon offenses, prior detention admission history, alcohol/drug use, previous alcohol/drug treatment

Family Domain: Guilford County youth involved with the system report experience being kicked out and being a runaway

School Domain: Guilford County youth have low academic performance and are failing most classes, are interested but not involved in school activities

Applicants are being sought that are able to address items below:

- 1. Program services compatible with research that are shown to be effective with juvenile offenders.
- 2. Program services are outcome-based.
- 3. The program has an evaluation component.
- 4. Program services detect gang participation and divert individuals from gang participation.
- 5. Awareness of and sensitivity to Racial Ethnic Disparity that exists in the County.
- 6. Programs are encouraged to provide effective programming that includes restorative justice practices.

Only local public agencies, 501c3 non-profit corporations and local housing authorities will be considered for funding.
