REMEMBER

- Do not make direct payments to the custodial parent as you will not receive credit for the payments
- ✓ You are responsible for making sure your child support gets paid –even if it is supposed to be withheld automatically from your paycheck

CHILD SUPPORT BASICS

Child support is designed to meet the needs of children while being fair to both parents. The amount that you pay is based on each parent's income.

Child support helps pay for things that all kids need, such as food, clothing, housing, transportation, and school supplies. Your regular child support payments can make the difference between your child's financial security and living in poverty.

How It Works

At the Guilford County Child Support Enforcement Agency, our responsibilities are to:

- Establish, monitor and enforce child support and medical support orders
- ✓ Collect and distribute support owed to children
