- 1. Describe how your agency intends to actively participate in Coordinated Entry System.
- 2. Describe how your agency intends to actively participate in the Continuum of Care.
- 3. Describe your agency budget summary of your requested amount.
- 4. Describe how your agency has or intends to have clear policies to ensure confidentiality and compliance with the VAWA, which is a federal law that, in part, provides protections for persons who have experienced domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking, or other unsafe conditions to reduce their likelihood of experiencing homelessness.
- 5. Describe how your agency will ensure substance use treatment services will be available on-site for program participants.
- 6. Describe how your agency involves individuals from a broad range of backgrounds in its Board of Directors, subcommittees, or advisory/program planning groups, and explain how the agency collects input from all persons that may not have traditionally participated in these processes.
- 7. Describe how your agency's Board, leadership, and staff have worked to examine and address factors that may contribute to differences in service delivery or outcomes among various populations. Include any efforts to review or revise policies, or to seek training or technical assistance aimed at improving service delivery.
