



## TERMINATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY GUILFORD COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA

**WHEREAS**, on the 22nd day of January 2026 at noon, pursuant to Article 1A of Chapter 166A of the North Carolina General Statutes and Article II of Chapter 7.5 of the Guilford County Code of Ordinances, a State of Emergency was declared within the jurisdiction of Guilford County due to the forecasted snow and ice accumulations and associated icy roads, downed power lines and trees resulting in power outages throughout the county; and

**WHEREAS**, said declaration of a State of Emergency applied to the entire jurisdiction of Guilford County, including the City of Greensboro, City of High Point, Towns of Gibsonville, Jamestown, Pleasant Garden, Sedalia, Stokesdale, Summerfield, Oak Ridge, and Whitsett; and

**WHEREAS**, conditions constituting a State of Emergency no longer exist in Guilford County.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, by the power vested in me as Chairman of the Guilford County Board of Commissioners it is hereby proclaimed that the State of Emergency declared on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of January, 2026, is terminated as of 10:00AM on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2026.
